# TRANSFER PATHWAY GUIDE 2024-2025

Associate of Arts to Bachelor of Science in Nursing (Traditional)

#### Overview

Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy the requirements for the Associate of Arts degree at Cincinnati State and leads to the Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) degree at Northern Kentucky University.

Note: This is a 2 + 3 program. Three full years will be required to complete the BSN degree after transferring to NKU.

#### Applying to the CState2NKU Program

Students can apply to participate in the pathway program by completing the online application on the NKU transfer webpage. Students must be enrolled in at least six credit hours at Cincinnati State, enrolled in an associate degree program, plan to transfer to NKU, and maintain a minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA at Cincinnati State.

#### Degree Requirements for Cincinnati State

1) Completion of minimum 62 credit hours, 36 of which from approved Ohio Transfer 36 courses, 2) minimum cumulative GPA 2.0, 3) completion of an FYE course as part of the first 12 credit hours taken at Cincinnati State, and 4) completion of Cooperative Education.

#### **Admission Requirements for NKU**

Students completing an associate degree with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher will be accepted into NKU.

To be considered for the selective admission to the B.S.N. program all applicants must:

- Be admitted to NKU as a degree-seeking student with no academic deficiencies.
- Submit a separate application to the nursing program. Applications to the nursing program may

also be submitted online

(<a href="http://healthprofessions.nku.edu/departments/nursing/undergrad/form.html">http://healthprofessions.nku.edu/departments/nursing/undergrad/form.html</a>). Applications to the nursing program are in addition to the university application.

- Have a minimum GPA of 2.50 if student has earned 24 or more credit hours. Transfer students
  with fewer than 24 earned credit hours must have a minimum GPA of 2.50, a minimum ACT
  composite score of 20 or higher and no academic deficiencies.
- Have the following minimum grade requirements and eligibilities (courses in parentheses are Cincinnati State equivalent courses):
  - o A minimum grade of C or higher in BIO 208/BIO 208L (BIO 151),
  - o A minimum grade of C or higher in PSY 100 (PSY 110),
  - o Be eligible to take CHE 115/CHE 115L (CHE 115),
  - o Be eligible to take STA 205 or STA 205R (MAT 131 + MAT 132)
  - o Be eligible to take BIO 209/BIO 209L (BIO 152)
  - Earn grades in nursing support courses of C or higher. Support courses include PSY 100 (PSY 110), PSY 321 (PSY 225) OR –EDU 300 (EDU 210), STA 205 OR STA 205R (MAT 131 + MAT 132), HIN 355 (HIM 120), BIO 202/BIO 202L (BIO 220), BIO 126 (DT 120), CHE 115/CHE 115L (CHE 115) OR CHE 120/CHE 120L (CHE 121/131) and CHE 121/CHE 121L (CHE 122/132). Grades of C- are not accepted for prerequisites, corequisites or nursing classes.
  - A minimum cumulative GPA of 3.00 on a 4.00-point scale or 3.00 on a 4.00 scale on all previous college work for the last 30 credit hours, whichever is higher. GPAs for admission to the B.S.N. program will be calculated using NKU and transfer coursework.
  - No more than one semester of science course failures in the required science courses for the program in the last two years (*C-, D,* and *F* are considered failures) prior to entry into the program. This requirement applies to BIO 120/BIO 120L, BIO 121/BIO 121L, BIO 126, BIO 202/BIO 202L, BIO 208/BIO 208L, BIO 209/BIO 209L, BIO 302/BIO 302L, CHE 102, CHE 115/CHE 115L, CHE 120/CHE 120L, CHE 121/CHE 121L or equivalent transfer courses.
  - Prerequisite science courses required for admission must be fewer than five years old as of the first day of the semester in which the program begins.

All accepted students must pass a criminal background check before starting nursing classes. A personal interview may be requested by the nursing admission/readmission committee.

Students who apply by January 1 are applying to begin nursing courses the following fall semester. Students who apply by August 1 are applying to begin nursing courses the following spring semester.

#### Degree Requirements for NKU

To earn a bachelor's degree at NKU, students must complete a minimum of 120 credit hours with at least 45 credit hours numbered 300 and above. In addition, at least 25% of the credit hours required for the degree and the last 30 credit hours must be completed at NKU. Students must have an overall GPA of 2.0 and meet all prerequisites for courses and requirements for the major.

#### **Advising Note**

Students in the CState2NKU program should work closely with their advisors when choosing courses. This document serves as a guide but does not replace academic advising. When choosing Cincinnati State courses, student may also consult the Associate of Arts advising brochure or the catalog for A and B list courses in Arts and Humanities or Social and Behavioral Sciences.
